Dear Parent of a High School or Carnegie Grade 8 Student:

The Rockdale County Public Schools strive to provide our students with experiences that will prepare them to function effectively as students and citizens. We perceive this as an obligation to the students, their parents, and the community.

The growth and development of young people are important and it is essential to give careful consideration in providing meaningful experiences for them. In our curriculum, all pertinent concepts are presented in a logical, sequential manner beginning in kindergarten. Kindergartners are taught that creatures of the same kind produce others of the same kind, middle school students are introduced to the correct anatomical terminology while identifying the physical and emotional differences between males and females, and high school students receive training that will prepare them for parenting.

What follows is a summary of the objectives to be addressed in the high school growth and development unit of the Health Curriculum.

1. Through an introduction of correct terminology, students will be able to ask questions and discuss sexuality accurately.
2. Through group activities, students will be able to identify the physical and emotional changes that occur during adolescence.
3. Through discussions and digital video discs, students will identify differences between males and females.
4. Using lectures, class discussions, and digital video discs, students will study the biology of reproduction in humans.
5. Through discussions and digital video discs, students will learn behaviors appropriate for interacting with persons of the opposite sex.
6. Students will understand some of the problems related to sexuality and how to effectively avoid them.
7. Students will evaluate the effect of media on personal and family health.
8. Students will study about the transmission of HIV, the effects of AIDS, and cause/effects of STDs.
